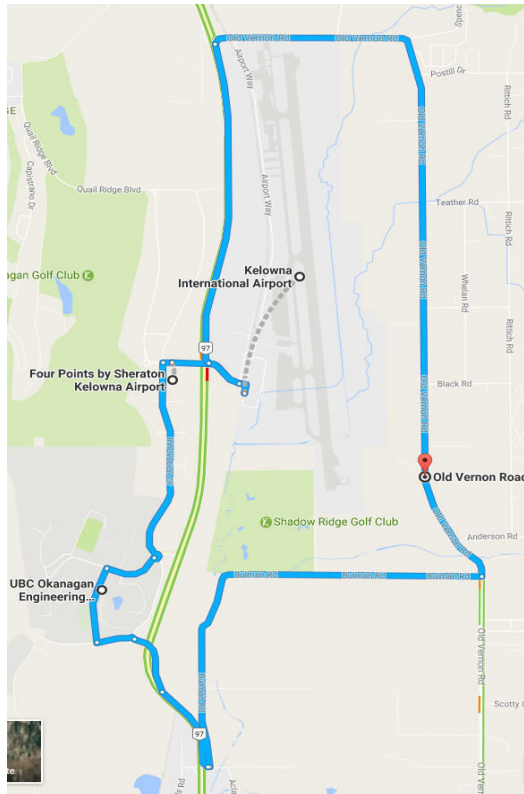

Ground Transportation:
